Quick Setup STB Codes

1. Hold SETUP plus the digit key 6, until the STB device key blinks twice.

Manual Code Entry

1. Hold SETUP until the STB key blinks twice. Enter the four digit code:
A D B - 2 2 5 4
I S 5 0 4 5 - 1 3 7 6
2. Verify that the STB key blinks twice to confirm the code is stored

STB, TV, DVD, AUX

Use one remote to control multiple devices

SETUP

Use for programming sequences of devices controlled by the remote.

Rew / FF / Stop / Pause / Play / Replay / Fwd

In STB mode, these control the program or DVR functions

Menu

Displays the menu

Guide

Opens the interactive program guide

Day +/-

Jump ahead or back one day in the Interactive Program Guide

RED, GREEN, YELLOW, BLUE

Access additional features on your STB.

Volume +/-

Raise or lower the volume

Fave

View your favorite channels.

Mute

In TV mode, turns the sound on/off

Input

In TV control mode, will change the input of the device you are controlling.

Power

Turn on/off a selected device

Live

Returning to watching live TV

List

Display a list of recorded future and series rules on your DVR.

Info

Displays the current channel and program information. Press again for more detail

Browse, Search, Arrow, and OK

Navigate and select on screen choices

Page +/-

Page up or down in lists and Interactive Program Guide.

Channel +/-

Changes to the next higher or lower channel.

Last

Recall the last channel you were watching

Number Keys (0-9)

Directly select a channel or enter options

Other Features:

A. FAVORITES

1. Create a list with your favorite channels

A. 5 additional Favorites Lists:

- I. Press Menu. Arrow down to **"Settings"** and then arrow right to **"Edit Favorites"**. Press **OK**.
- II. Using the Arrow buttons, move through the channels and press **OK** to add or remove a channel to your Favorites List. Or, type in a channel using the number keys. The channels added to your Favorites List are marked with a **"checkmark"**.
- III. When finished selecting your favorite channels, press the Blue button to save your list.

B. Using Favorite Lists:

- I. Press FAV. By default, your list is 'All' channels.
- II. Arrow Up/Down to select your Favorites List and Press OK.
- III. Use the Channel Up/Down buttons or the Arrow buttons to change the channels in the selected list. Or, use the direction up/down buttons to navigate the channels on the selected list and direction left/right to view previous and future channel programs.
- IV. To leave a Favorites List, press FAV. Arrow Up/Down to select **"All Channels"** and press **OK**.
- V. Additionally, you can press the blue button to switch between your favorites list.

A. REMINDERS:

Set Reminders: While viewing the guide, highlight the program where you want a reminder and press 'OK'.

Follow the instructions below to easily program your remote and start controlling your device.

- 1.) Turn **ON** the TV that you want to setup on the remote.
- 2.) Point the remote to the device you would like to pair. Then press the corresponding **device key** (**TV, DVD, VCR, AUD, or STB button**).
- 3.) Press and hold **SETUP** until the device key blinks twice.
- 4.) Find the brand of your device from the chart below. Press the **DIGIT** key for your device/brand.
- 5.) You can now control your device with the remote.

If you prefer your external audio device or soundbar as the default audio output controlled by your remote, follow these steps:

Lock the volume keys to the **AUD** device.

- Hold **SETUP** until the device key blinks twice
- Enter 993
- Press VOL +
- Press **AUD**
