The selected Bidder shall be required to obtain all permits and comply with all Federal and Territorial laws, ordinances, or rules applicable to its professional licensing and the provision of equipment and services to GTA. The Bidder shall provide a copy of its current 214 FCC License or applicable licenses and permits prior to the award of the bid. Any government required licensure for operating on Guam shall be the responsibility of the Bidder.
